General Foreman is Journeyman Iron Workers' rate plus \$4.00 per hour.

All Crane equipment that requires State or Federal Certification or Certification of training, shall be paid \$1.50 per hour above the rate for the year 2006.
An Iron Worker required to have an Electrical License will receive an additional \$1.00 per hour.
